- 3. That the school authority shall provide retirement benefits to the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school as per a Death Cum Retirement Benefit Scheme.
- 4. That the managing committee of the school shall be constituted with at least three guardian members, three elected teacher members and one non-teaching staff. The Principal will be an Ex-officio member of the Managing Committee.
- 5.(a) That the school authority shall not enhance tuition fees or other charges without prior permission of the competent authority.
  - (b) That the school shall not charge any capitation fee or equivalent to capitation fee by any means.
- 6. That the recruitment of teachers shall be done in accordance with transparent, merit-based criteria, to be laid down in the Memorandum of Parent Body and information thereof shall be made available to the State Government, if necessary.
- 7. That the funds raised by the school authority, the fees collected and earned income by any other source, shall not be utilized for any other purpose than the welfare of the school and benefit of education of the students and the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school.
